2 Summary of Job Description

The aging of the population in the PRC is one of the most important demographic challenges facing the country, which has significant health, social and economic impacts. Traditional family support systems are increasingly unable to meet elderly care needs because of the combined impacts of fast urbanization, internal migration of youth away from rural areas, and the one-child policy. In order responded to the challenges, PRC highlight the creation of a three-tiered elderly care system, with home-based care as the base, community care as the support, and residential care as a supplement.

Since 2013, ADB have provided TAs and loans of over \$600 million to support the development of three-tiered elderly care systems in provinces and cities. There's a need to review the on-going elder care projects to summarize the experience and lessons learned to improve the quality and innovation of forthcoming elderly care projects.
